DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What part of the teaching stood out most to you? Why?
2. How do you typically respond to opposition? Do you retaliate or retreat? Does it work?
3. You don't have to be facing an angry mob like Stephen was to be able to walk in Jesus' power. How do you walk in Jesus' power as you face little oppositions every day? What does it mean to walk in Jesus' power?
4. The opposition that we all face is death. We can't retaliate against death and we can't retreat from death. How do you feel when you think about death? Why do you think Stephen was able to face death?
5. Look at the final words of Stephen in Acts 7:59-60. What stands out to you about what he says?
6. The gospel is hard to hear because it says "you are so broken you can't fix anything". But, it also says "you are so loved that Jesus fixed everything". What do you think about these two statements? How do they make you feel? Do you believe them?
7. This is the final week of the spring semester! Has God been teaching you anything over these last 15 weeks? What plans and expectations do you have for the summer?
8. Consider spending some extra time this week taking prayer requests and praying for one another as we enter into the summer season.
