

WEEK 3: AMAZING GRACE

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What part of the teaching stood out most to you? Why?
2. In Galatians 1:11-24, Paul is basically answering the question "Is the gospel made up?" Have you ever gotten into an argument about Christianity? How did it go? What arguments did you use? Have you ever shared your personal testimony as your "argument"?
3. People in our culture often have to run from or deny their past mistakes. As a Christian, you are free to point to your past sins to proclaim the grace of God. Paul did this often. What from your past has God used to bring glory to Himself? How is God able to redeem even our worst decisions in our past?
4. The second idea this week was that "God's Grace Changes Our Trajectory". Where do you think you would be today if not for God getting a hold of you?
5. God's grace will lead us to places and have us do things that we would never expect. What are some examples from your life of God working in this way?
6. Pastor Ryan talked about how it can take time for grace to develop us and it isn't a waste of time when we are in a waiting period (like Paul's 3 years in Arabia or David's time running from Saul). Do you feel like you are currently in a waiting period? How do you navigate these times of waiting?
7. **APPLICATION:** Pastor Ryan talked about how there is no greater evidence for the truth of Christianity than a life that has been changed by Jesus. Try to talk to one person this week about how God has changed your life.
