

WEEK 8- GOD IS ON OUR SIDE

Galatians 3:10-14

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What part of the teaching stood out most to you? Why?
2. We have now been in the book of Galatians for 8 weeks. What have you thought about the series so far? Has anything impacted you? Has anything confused you?
3. This passage of Galatians 3:10-14 contrasts "curse" and "blessing". What do you think of when you hear the word "curse"? What do you think of when you hear the word "blessing"?
4. Pastor Ryan told the story of Hosea and Gomer to illustrate the idea of being "redeemed". How do you think you would have responded if you were Hosea and God told you to marry a prostitute and then told you to buy her back after she had returned to her old way of life? What are some things we can learn about God from this story?
5. This week, Pastor Ryan said that Jesus didn't come to be your example, He came to be your substitute. Why do you think that distinction is significant?
6. When we are justified we are "declared to be as we ought to be" or "seen as we wish to be considered". How do you want to be perceived by people? How do you think God perceives you?
7. The final idea this week was that "Jesus Gives Us the Relationship We've Always Wanted." If we have put our faith in Jesus we have the Holy Spirit living in us, making our body a temple (1 Cor 6:19-20). How does this affect our relationship with God? What does this mean for how we live our lives?
8. How is God able to justify guilty sinners while still being a just judge?
