1 Peter 1:10-12

1. WE SHOULD VALUE WHAT GOD HAS DONE FOR US MORE THAN ANYTHING ELSE
2. WE SHOULD LOOK INTO THE GOSPEL MORE THAN ANYTHING ELSE

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. This week, Ryan talked about the salvation we have in Jesus. Did you learn anything new about salvation from this teaching? Which of the three kinds of salvation (from sin's punishment, sin's power, or sin's presence) is most meaningful to you? Why? Are you sure you have this salvation? Why or why not?
2. The first point in this weekend's teaching was, "We should value what God has done for us more than anything else." What do you value? What does your schedule and your wallet (how you spend your time and money) say about what you value? Do you think your values need realignment? Why?
3. What is the Gospel?
4. What would you say to someone who is trying to go through life in and of their own power?
5. Jesus said that the entire Bible, Old and New Testaments, are about Him. What does that mean? How can the story of the Exodus, the story of Rahab in the city of Jericho, the book of Ruth, or the story of David and Goliath actually be about Jesus?
6. Two ways Ryan talked about obsessing over the Gospel were reading the Bible (with the understanding that it is all about Jesus) and community. Do you "obsess" over the Gospel? What roadblock in your life is keeping you from doing this?
