DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What part of the teaching stood out most to you? Why?
2. In Acts 3 and 4 we see that **Jesus' mission comes with a price**. What did this mean for Peter and John? What did this mean for the early church? What do you think this means for us today? Have you ever faced hardship because of your faith?
3. Do you ever feel like you don't know enough or aren't good enough to be used by God? What do you think is required of us before we can be used in God's mission? What do we have to offer to the people around us?
4. In the culture of Jesus' day, they would have believed that the beggar's situation would have been punishment for either sin within him or in his family. This was based on a wrong view of God and of himself. What was wrong with this view and how did Peter address it? How did Jesus address the same mindset in John 9:1-3? Are there any wrong views about God that are commonly held in our culture?
5. The focus/purpose of the church is to point people to Jesus. Do we believe this? Do we live like it's true? What does this mean for how we live our lives?
6. Is there anyone who God has placed on your heart that you know you need to reach out to with the hope of the gospel? What practical steps can you take this week to make sure you touch base with this person?
7. Spend some time praying together as a group. Remember how great God is and ask for boldness to speak the truth in love to the people around us.
