DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What part of this week's teaching stood out to you the most? Why?
2. This week was all about Finding God's Will for your life. The first step in that process is finding what God has uniquely wired you to care about. What are you passionate about?
3. How can we tell when something we care about is a God-given passion? Have you ever known beyond a shadow of a doubt that God was calling you to do something? What was that like?
4. One of the main ideas this week was to "Act on Your Passion". If you have an idea of what you're passionate about and you're convinced it's from God, what have you done about it so far? What are you willing to do about it moving forward?
5. We see in Nehemiah 2:2 that you can be right in the center of God's will and still be terrified. What fears have you faced when trying to walk in line with the specific calling God has on your life?
6. Nehemiah didn't have any good reasons to think he could make a big difference but God had something big for him to do. Do you ever feel inadequate or that you can't be used by God? What do you think is at the root of why you feel this way? What are some truths we can hold on to when we don't feel like God can use us?
7. Why do you think it's important that we take our passions to God? What does it actually look like to do this?
8. Prayer is not about getting God on board with our agenda it is about getting us on board with His. Spend some time praying for each other and for clarity and courage regarding the callings that God has on each of your lives.
