DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What part of this week's teaching stood out to you the most? Why?
2. All the signs recorded in the book of John are meant to point us to Jesus. What are some things about Jesus that you've learned or been reminded of so far in this series?
3. The way Jesus treated the crowd in John 6 shows that people were never a means to an end for Jesus. He came to love people, serve people and reach people. Do you ever find it hard to believe that Jesus could value people so much? If so, why?
4. Anything we look to in this world for satisfaction will eventually leave us hungry or thirsty again. Have you ever experienced this in your life? What different things have you chased after that you eventually discovered couldn't satisfy you?
5. In John 6, Jesus doesn't just feed the crowd a small meal. He made so much food that there were 12 baskets full of leftovers. This shows us that Jesus provides and He provides abundantly. But this does not mean that everyone who follows Jesus will have tons of food and money. So what do you think this abundance actually looks like in our lives?
6. This week Pastor Ryan talked about the fact that Jesus DID claim to be God in many ways. Just a few examples are that He claimed to have the power to judge, He claimed to have the power to give life and He claimed that all scripture was about HIM. Why do you think this is so important? Why can't Jesus just be a good teacher or prophet?
7. As we approach Easter weekend, take some time as a group to pray for the people being baptized and for the many visitors we will have coming to Severn.
