DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

3. The Holy Spirit helps us truly experience the fact that God loves us and that He is our father. When's the last time you experienced "inner wonder" towards God?
4. No particular culture has the ability to corner the market on Christianity. Instead, Jesus reaches into every culture in the world and renews those who are in it without removing them from their culture. What does this mean for how we view others who may worship Jesus differently than us? How might this affect the way we view our own version of Christianity?
5. What do you think it looks like to be obsessed with the gospel? What would it look like in your life specifically?
6. How does Pentecost in Acts 2:1-13 compare to when God appeared to the people of Israel at Mt. Sinai? How about to the Tower of Babel?
7. What's one thing you heard in the sermon that you'd like to apply in your life or learn more about? What's your plan to make that happen?
