MAIN IDEAS FROM THIS WEEK

1. CHRISTIANITY MAKES SENSE RATIONALLY
2. CHRISTIANITY MAKES SENSE EMOTIONALLY
3. CHRISTIANITY MAKES SENSE BIBLICALLY

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS – Pick one or two of these to talk about as a group

1. What stood out to you most from this week's message? Why
2. The first main idea this week was that "Christianity Makes Sense Rationally." What books, messages, arguments, events, ideas or people have helped you see that Christianity makes sense rationally?
3. Another main idea from this week's message was that "Christianity Makes Sense Emotionally." What experiences in your life have helped you see that Christianity makes sense emotionally?
4. Pastor Ryan stated that the purpose of this week's message was to build your faith. Was your faith built up by hearing this week's message? If so, how?
5. Paul was able to boldly and confidently speak the way he did because he knew that, in Jesus, he had forgiveness and a place with God (i.e. a home with God where he is welcomed and loved). Do you KNOW you have forgiveness and a home with God too? What makes you think you do/ don't have these things?
6. The final idea from this week's message was that "Christianity Makes Sense Biblically." The Bible is where the rational and emotional come together because the Bible is all about Jesus. What is your approach to spending time in the Bible?
7. **OPEN DISCUSSION:** People often assume that faith in Jesus is a blind faith. Take some time to discuss why it is not a blind faith. This could be a good opportunity to discuss questions that anyone has about their faith. You could also discuss opposing world views and the faith required to hold those views.
