### MAIN IDEAS FROM THIS WEEK

1. GOD CHANGES THE WORLD THROUGH RECONCILIATION
2. GOD CHANGES THE WORLD THROUGH HIS PEOPLE
3. GOD CHANGES THE WORLD THROUGH HIS POWER

### DISCUSSION QUESTIONS – Pick one or two of these to talk about as a group

1. What stood out to you most from this week's message? Why?
2. This week's message was all about how God changes the world. What are some changes that you'd like to see in the world?
3. The first main idea this week was that "God changes the world through reconciliation." The reason we have to start with reconciliation with God is because our relationship with God is our PRIMARY relationship from which all others flow. What are some ways that how you relate to God can affect how you relate to yourself, others and the rest of the world?
4. What insecurities or concerns surface in your mind when you think of being a part of God's plan to change the world? Does the story of Jonah address any of the concerns you have?
5. If God can work through a guy like Jonah to change a place like Nineveh, He can work through you to change your family, workplace, country and world. What is one thing you can do today to be an agent of reconciliation?
6. The final idea this week was that "God changes the world through His power." What are some examples of positive change that you've seen in individuals or the world around you that you know is only possible because of God?
7. **OPEN DISCUSSION:** Discuss, in specific details, what it might look like for you to participate in God's plan to change the world. This can include both how to tell people about Jesus and how to show people the love of Jesus by our actions. It can include personal ideas and group ideas. Close by praying for God to give you wisdom and bring transformation by His power.
