DISCUSSION QUESTIONS – Pick one or two of these to talk about as a group

1. What stood out to you most from this week's message? Why?
2. This week we concluded our series through the book of Jonah. What is something you learned about God from the book of Jonah? What is something you learned about yourself?
3. The root cause of Jonah's struggles is that he doesn't understand God's love. What is the most difficult part of God's love for you to understand? How do you think this gap in your understanding affects the way you live?
4. Jonah cared about a plant. God cared about the city of Nineveh. What we weep over can help reveal whether we are inwardly or outwardly focused. What do you weep over?
5. What are some ways that God's love has refined you? Can you describe what that refining process was like as you were going through it?
6. Where are you experiencing pressure and trouble in your life right now? Is there any way the current pressure you are experiencing could be God's purifying love working in your life?
7. At the end of the day there comes a point where we have to put our trust in something or someone. What obstacles make it difficult for you to fully trust Jesus? What are some ways Jesus has shown Himself trustworthy in your life?
