1. What stood out to you most from this week's message? Why?

3. What does it mean to you that Jesus prayed for YOU personally in John 17?
4. The oneness that Jesus desires for us does not do away with our individual distinctiveness. What are some implications of this idea? What are some ways that 1 Corinthians 12 and the metaphor of the church being a "body" help expound on this idea?
5. Are you more interested in oneness or sameness? How do you know the difference between the two?
6. Jesus has given His people the SAME glory that the Father gave Him. How might you treat people differently if you totally believed and understood this immense value that Jesus places on each and every person?
