### DISCUSSION QUESTIONS – Pick one or two of these to talk about as a group

1. What stood out to you most from this week's message? Why?
2. The idea of "proselytizing" or "evangelism" can bring all kinds of ideas and memories into people's minds. What has your past experience been with evangelism (both positive and negative)? How does this impact your approach to sharing your faith with others today?
3. Pastor Ryan talked about how the great commission is for all believers, not just the apostles or the "experts". What are some creative and practical ways that you can be a part of this mission in your family, neighborhood, workplace, etc.? What are the barriers that might prevent you from living out this mission?
4. The great commission is something that we are all called to together. How can we encourage and support one another in this mission? How can we, as your small group, support you specifically?
5. **OPEN DISCUSSION:** Take time as a group to discuss how each one of us can be a part of Jesus' mission to go and make disciples. You can talk about the challenges that we face today, the opportunities around us, the areas you've seen success, the areas you have struggled and the areas you still have no idea what to do.
6. **PRAY:** Consider ending your group by praying, by name, for friends, family members, co-workers, etc. who you want to see come to know Jesus.
