MAIN IDEAS FROM THIS WEEK

1. JESUS OFFERS ULTIMATE SATISFACTION
2. YOU HAVE TO TRANSFER YOUR SPIRITUAL THIRST TO JESUS TO EXPERIENCE THE SATISFACTION HE OFFERS

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS – Pick one or two of these to talk about as a group

1. What stood out to you most from this week's message? Why?
2. When have you felt most satisfied in your life? What are some areas where you are dissatisfied?
3. What are some ways the satisfaction that Jesus offers is different from our other sources of satisfaction? What significance is there in the fact that Jesus offers us "living water"?
4. The "wells" we drink from might provide certain degrees of satisfaction but they will always leave us with a lingering, unquenched thirst. What are some things and/or people that you have looked to for satisfaction that have left you unsatisfied?
5. Jesus is the living water we all need. And yet, He experienced ultimate spiritual thirst so that we would never thirst again. Is there anything keeping you from putting Him at the center of your life and seeking your satisfaction in Him alone?
6. This week we concluded our "Remember" series. What was most encouraging to you from this series?
7. **OPEN DISCUSSION:** Have an open discussion about satisfaction. You can talk about where you've looked for it, where you've found it, where you haven't found it and what satisfaction in Jesus looks like.

A TRUTH TO TAKE WITH YOU: Infinite desires cannot be met by finite things. Every time we try to fill the bucket of our souls with anything other than God we are sabotaging our own satisfaction and hijacking our own lives.
