MAIN IDEAS FROM THIS WEEK

1. GOD IS A REAL GOD
2. GOD IS A GOD WHO CAN BE KNOWN
3. GOD IS A PARADOXICAL GOD
4. GOD IS A TRANSFORMING GOD

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS – Pick one or two of these to talk about as a group

1. What stood out to you most from this week's message? Why?
2. Most people still believe in a "higher power" or "god" of some sort. What are some ways you would describe God? Where does your description of God come from (i.e. specific experiences, specific things you've heard from others, specific passages in the Bible etc.)?
3. If God is real, then we don't get to decide what He is like. Is there anything about God you wish was different? How do you handle it when you feel this way about God?
4. When we recognize the "realness" of God it is both humbling and liberating. What are some ways it is humbling? What are some ways it is liberating?
5. Which of the 4 aspects of God that we talked about this week was most impactful to you? Why?
6. One of the main ideas this week was that "God is a God who can be known." Have you ever had a deeply personal encounter with God? What was it like?
7. **OPEN DISCUSSION:** This is the final week of the semester! Have an open discussion about how the semester went, what was good, what could have been better and what your plans are for next semester.

A TRUTH TO TAKE WITH YOU: God met Moses exactly where he was and transformed him into someone he never could have been apart from God. God can do the same for you.
