DISCUSSION QUESTIONS – Pick one or two of these to talk about as a group

1. What stood out to you most from this week's message? Why?
2. This week's message was about God's sovereignty. What is your understanding of God's sovereignty? Do you have any questions surrounding this aspect of God?
3. In Psalm 8, David is able to see God's glory when looking at the physical world that God created. What are some things you've learned about God through observing His creation?
4. Do you have a harder time seeing God as the sovereign creator of all things or as the loving Father who cares about you personally? Why do you think that is?
5. Seeing the greatness of God can leave us feeling insignificant. However, Psalm 8 also provides us with a unique sense of self-worth. What do you see in Psalm 8 that can help you see your worth more accurately? What are some things that make you lose sight of your value? Where do you personally find your self-worth?
6. Where are you currently experiencing bitterness or anxiety in your life? Was there anything about this week's message that was helpful to you in this area? Are there any ways you still need help in dealing with your bitterness or anxiety?
7. **BAPTISM:** This week, Pastor Ryan announced that we plan to do baptisms on Easter. Have you been baptized? If not, would you be interested in being baptized on Easter? Do you have any questions about baptism?
