DISCUSSION QUESTIONS – Pick one or two of these to talk about as a group

1. What stood out to you most from this week's message? Why?
2. Moses' life was filled with purpose after he encountered God. Where are you finding the most purpose in your life right now?
3. When God called Moses to go free the Israelites from slavery in Egypt, Moses responded by saying, "who am I that I should go to Pharaoh and that I should bring the Israelites out of Egypt?" What are the insecurities in your life that keep you from stepping out in faith? How did God respond to Moses' insecurity?
4. On Sunday, Pastor Ryan mentioned how God always shows up for people in exactly the way they need Him to. You could say God reaches people in a way that is "personalized." What are some examples of this from the Bible? How has this played out in your own life?
5. When we see the immensity of God it can save us from both arrogance and anxiety. How does it save us from arrogance? How does it save us from anxiety?
6. Are you aware of any specific God-given purposes in your life? What has it been like trying to live in that purpose?
7. If you are a Christian, you aren't just able to approach the presence of God, the presence of God is in you. You are a type of "burning bush". What makes this possible? What is the significance of this reality?
