DISCUSSION QUESTIONS – Pick one or two of these to talk about as a group

1. What stood out to you most from this week's message? Why?
2. We just started a new sermon series out of John 14 about confidence. What comes to mind when you think about confidence? Why is it important?
3. This week we focused on how Jesus offers us a hope that can bring us confidence. The hope Jesus offers in John 14:1-3 is a place that He has prepared for us. Where have you experienced the greatest sense of belonging in your life? Consider and discuss the implications of us having "a place" in the Father's house as opposed to simply "going to" the Father's house.
4. What makes heaven, heaven?
5. Three reasons this hope of heaven that Jesus' offers in John 14 is such a good hope are 1) We will witness the glory of Jesus in its fullness 2) We will be completely transformed by Jesus' perfect glory and 3) We will share in the joy of this experience with others. What stands out to you about this description of heaven? Do you find any of it surprising?
6. Would you consider yourself a hopeful person? Why or why not? Did this week's message help you think about hope any differently than you did before you heard it?
