MAIN IDEAS FROM THIS WEEK

1. KNOWING THE LOVE OF GOD PERSONALLY IS A CRITICAL COMPONENT OF ENDURING CONFIDENCE
2. KNOWING JESUS PERSONALLY IS HOW WE KNOW THE LOVE OF GOD PERSONALLY

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS – Pick one or two of these to talk about as a group

1. What stood out to you most from this week's message? Why?
2. This week's message was about the confidence we can have in the love of God. What human friendship/ relationship would you say you have the most confidence in the other person's love for you? What factors led to your confidence in that relationship?
3. What are some unique aspects about the love of God that no other type of love can offer?
4. There is a major difference between knowing about God's love and experiencing God's love. Describe a time when you personally experienced God's love. How were you impacted by that experience?
5. The request Philip makes of Jesus in John 14:8 is a picture of how we all desire absolute certainty in life. The more certain we are the more confident we are. Do you have any certainty about your relationship with God? If so, where does your certainty come from? If not, what contributes to your uncertainty?
6. **PRAY:** Spend time talking to God about the great love He has for you and ask that He would help us personally know and experience that love so that we can be completely changed by it.

A TRUTH TO TAKE WITH YOU: Jesus' death on the cross is what makes it possible for us to see God's love.
