DISCUSSION QUESTIONS – Pick one or two of these to talk about as a group

1. What stood out to you most from this week's message? Why?
2. This week's message was all about prayer. How would you describe your prayer life? Did this week's message make you think more specifically about any particular aspect of how you pray?
3. We need to know who we are talking to in order to be confident in prayer. What are some ways we can grow in our understanding of who God is?
4. Do you ever find yourself practicing "self-talk" instead of praying? How can you tell the difference? What are some ways to ensure you are talking to the One True God?
5. In John 14:12-14 we see that we are told to pray in Jesus' name. What does it mean to be a person who prays in Jesus' name? Do you have any examples of passages in scripture that help expand on this idea?
6. The promise Jesus makes about prayer in John 14:12-14 is tied directly to our purpose of continuing Jesus' work in the world. What is Jesus' work in the world and how are we a part of it? Have you noticed any connections between how you view your purpose in life and how you pray?
7. **PRAY:** Spend time praying as a group that God would make us into people have hearts that are in line with His.
