MAIN IDEAS FROM THIS WEEK

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS – Pick one or two of these to talk about as a group

1. What stood out to you most from this week's message? Why?
2. This week we read about a future king that will completely heal and transform the world. Why do you think mankind has so many stories that end with a good king taking his rightful place on the throne and making all things right?
3. Do you view Jesus as a king? If so, what are some ways you relate to Jesus as your king?
4. Jesus is a king of matchless wisdom. His wisdom is not only infinitely greater than our wisdom it is also completely different from our wisdom. What are some things we should expect in our journey if we are following someone who is so much wiser than us?
5. Jesus is a king of matchless justice. What aspect of God's justice is most encouraging to you? Which aspect of God's justice is most challenging to you? What are some implications of God's perfect justice?
6. When we follow Jesus as king, He will often lead us where we don't want to go. Where is Jesus currently leading you that you don't want to go?
7. This is the final week of the fall small-group semester! What are some ways we can plan to stay in touch through the winter break? (**Note:** The spring small-group semester is set to begin the week of February 12th.)
