1. What stood out to you most from this week's message? Why?

3. Our fear of inadequacy leads to us trying to cover ourselves with all kinds of "fig leaves" just like Adam and Eve in the garden. What are your fig leaves?
4. In Luke 2, we see that Jesus came to be a savior. How does this simple fact make Christianity different from every other major world religion?
5. Jesus came to satisfy the desires in us that nothing in this world can satisfy. How does Jesus do this? Have you experienced this in any way?
6. God orchestrated the birth of Jesus so that shepherds could have direct access to Jesus and so that WE can have direct access to Jesus. How does this truth impact you?
