1. MONEY DISTORTS THE VIEW WE HAVE

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS – Pick one or two of these to talk about as a group

1. What stood out to you most from this week's message? Why?
2. How would you describe your relationship with money?
3. We all tend to look for money for either our significance or our security. When we look to money for our significance we will tend to spend it. When we look to it for our security we will tend to save it. Which sounds more like you?
4. We can get a quick view of the state of our heart by looking at where our money goes. Where does your money flow most effortlessly and joyfully?
5. Greed is something that we can often see in others but cannot see in ourselves. Who have you given permission to speak into your life about money? What might this type of accountability look like practically? What factors make you hesitant to give someone else this sort of authority in our life?
6. Jesus didn't even own a house while He was living here. However, Jesus' solution for us when it comes to money isn't to avoid having it. His solution is to be radically generous with whatever we have. What does this kind of generosity look like? What are the main factors that make it difficult for you to be generous?
7. How do we become people who are cheerful givers? How has Jesus personally transformed the way you give?
